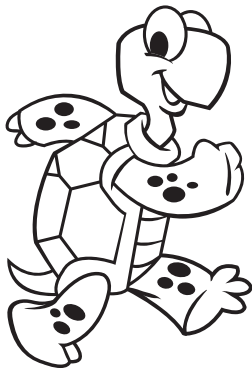


Winter Scavenger Hunt
